PARISH NEWS

Haitian Health Foundation Collection

On June 6, 2023 a 4.9 Richter earthquake struck Haiti, Jeremie area. Information on deaths, injuries, and damage is still coming in, but as of June 7, there were: 51 dead. 18 missing, 140 injured, 1,625 houses damaged, 820 houses destroyed, 31,591 houses flooded, 39.458 homeless

The Haitian Health Foundation (HHF) serves the Jeremie area and 105 rural villages, totaling 250,000 of this hemisphere's poorest and most vulnerable people. HHF has 5 clinics in greater Jeremie, serving many rural villages. One of their clinics was damaged - the Center of Hope, which is an inpatient facility for village women in high-risk pregnancies and children with severe malnutrition.

HHF has served Haiti for 41 years, and they remain committed to their mission to serve the poorest of the poor. Their staff of 260 in Haiti continues to work diligently to provide survival to those who have no other place to turn.

On June 24 and 25th at St. Joseph Church we will have a second collection to support poor people in Haiti through Haitian Health Foundation

6 czerwca 2023 r. trzęsienie ziemi o sile 4,9 w skali Richtera nawiedziło Haiti w rejonie Jeremie. Wciąż napływają informacje o ofiarach śmiertelnych, rannych i zniszczeniach, ale według stanu na 7 czerwca było: 51 zabitych. 18 zaginionych, 140 rannych, 1625 uszkodzonych domów, 820 zniszczonych domów, 31 591 domów zalanych, 39 458 bezdomnych

Haitian Health Foundation (HHF) obsługuie obszar Jeremie i 105 wiosek wiejskich, w sumie 250 000 najbiedniejszych i najbardziej narażonych ludzi na tej półkuli. HHF ma 5 klinik w większym Jeremie, obsługujących wiele wiosek wiejskich. Uszkodzona została jedna z ich klinik – Centrum Nadziei, które jest placówką stacjonarną dla kobiet ze wsi w zagrożonych ciążach i dzieci z ciężkim niedożywieniem.

HHF służy Haiti od 41 lat i pozostaje oddany swojej misji służenia najuboższym z biednych. Ich 260-osobowy personel na Haiti nadal pilnie pracuje, aby zapewnić przetrwanie tym, którzy nie mają innego miejsca, do którego mogliby się zwrócić.

24 i 25 czerwca w kościele św. Józefa odbędzie się druga zbiórka na wsparcie biednych ludzi na Haiti za pośrednictwem Haitian Health Foundation.
