Today's Second Collection for Haitian Health Foundation and the people of Jeremie, Haiti

On June 6, 2023 a 4.9 Richter earthquake struck Haiti, Jeremie area. Information on deaths, injuries, and damage is still coming in, but as of June 7, there were: 51 dead, 18 missing, 140 injured, 1,625 houses damaged, 820 houses destroyed, 31,591 houses flooded, 39,458 homeless

The Haitian Health Foundation (HHF) serves the Jeremie area and 105 rural villages, totaling 250,000 of this hemisphere's poorest and most vulnerable people. HHF has 5 clinics in greater Jeremie, serving many rural villages. One of their clinics was damaged – the Center of Hope, which is an inpatient facility for village women in high-risk pregnancies and children with severe malnutrition.

HHF has served Haiti for 41 years, and they remain committed to their mission to serve the poorest of the poor. Their staff of 260 in Haiti continues to work diligently to provide survival to those who have no other place to turn.
