Blessed Father Michael McGivney

The official feast day in the life of the Catholic Church in the State of Connecticut of Blessed Father Michael Joseph McGivney, Patron and Founder of the Knights of Columbus, is celebrated annually on August 13th. Blessed Father McGivney was born on August 12th, 1852 in Waterbury, Connecticut and died on August 14th, 1890 at age 38 in Thomaston, Connecticut. His feast day is celebrated on the 13th because it falls between these two dates. Blessed Father McGivney was beatified on October 31st, 2020 at the Cathedral of Saint Joseph in Hartford, Connecticut by Cardinal Joseph W. Tobin, Archbishop of Newark, New Jersey on behalf of Pope Francis. Saint Mary Church in New Haven, Connecticut is the shrine and burial place for Blessed Father Michael Joseph McGivney; a place where he served during his brief life as a priest and where he founded the Knights of Columbus.

Today he is invoked by so many as an "apostle to the young," "protector of catholic family life," and "saintly founder of the Knights of Columbus." May he bless our state of Connecticut, our parishes, our priests, deacons, seminarians, and consecrated religious brothers and sisters on his feast day!
