

Solemnity of the Assumption

of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a Holy Day of Obligation in the United States. Mass will be available at each Parish as follows:

8am at Sacred Heart Church 9am Mass at St. Joseph Church 6pm Mass at St. John Mission

All the feast days of Mary mark the great mysteries of her life and her part in the work of redemption. The central mystery of her life and person is her divine motherhood, celebrated both at Christmas and a week later (Jan. 1) on the feast of the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. The Immaculate Conception (Dec. 8) marks the preparation for that motherhood, so that she had the fullness of grace from the first moment of her existence, completely untouched by sin. Her whole being throbbed with divine life from the very beginning, readying her for the exalted role of mother of the Savior

The Assumption completes God's work in her since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over.

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they do not look only to the past. They look to the present and to the future and give us an insight into our own relationship with God. The Assumption looks to eternity and gives us hope that we, too, will follow Our Lady when our life is ended.

Wniebowzięcie

Wszystkie święta Maryi są znakiem wielkich tajemnic Jej życia i Jej udziału w dziele odkupienia. Centralną tajemnicą Jej życia i osoby jest Jej Boskie Macierzyństwo, obchodzone zarówno w Boże Narodzenie, jak i tydzień później (1 stycznia) w uroczystość Bożej Rodzicielki Maryi. Niepokalane Poczęcie (8 grudnia) oznacza przygotowanie do tego macierzyństwa, aby od pierwszej chwili swego istnienia, zupełnie nieskażona grzechem, miała pełnię łaski. Cała Jej istota od samego początku pulsowała boskim życiem, przygotowując Ją do wzniosłej roli Matki Zbawiciela.

Wniebowzięcie dopełnia w niej dzieła Bożego, ponieważ nie przystoi, aby ciało, które dało życie samemu Bogu, uległo zepsuciu. Wniebowzięcie jest ukoronowaniem Bożego dzieła, gdy Maryja kończy swoje ziemskie życie i wchodzi do wieczności. Uczta kieruje nasze oczy w tamtą stronę, dokąd pójdziemy, gdy nasze ziemskie życie się skończy.

Święta Kościoła to nie tylko upamiętnienie wydarzeń historycznych; nie patrzą tylko w przeszłość. Patrzą w teraźniejszość i przyszłość i dają nam wgląd w naszą własną relację z Bogiem. Wniebowzięcie patrzy na wieczność i daje nam nadzieję, że i my pójdziemy za Matką Bożą, gdy nasze życie dobiegnie.
