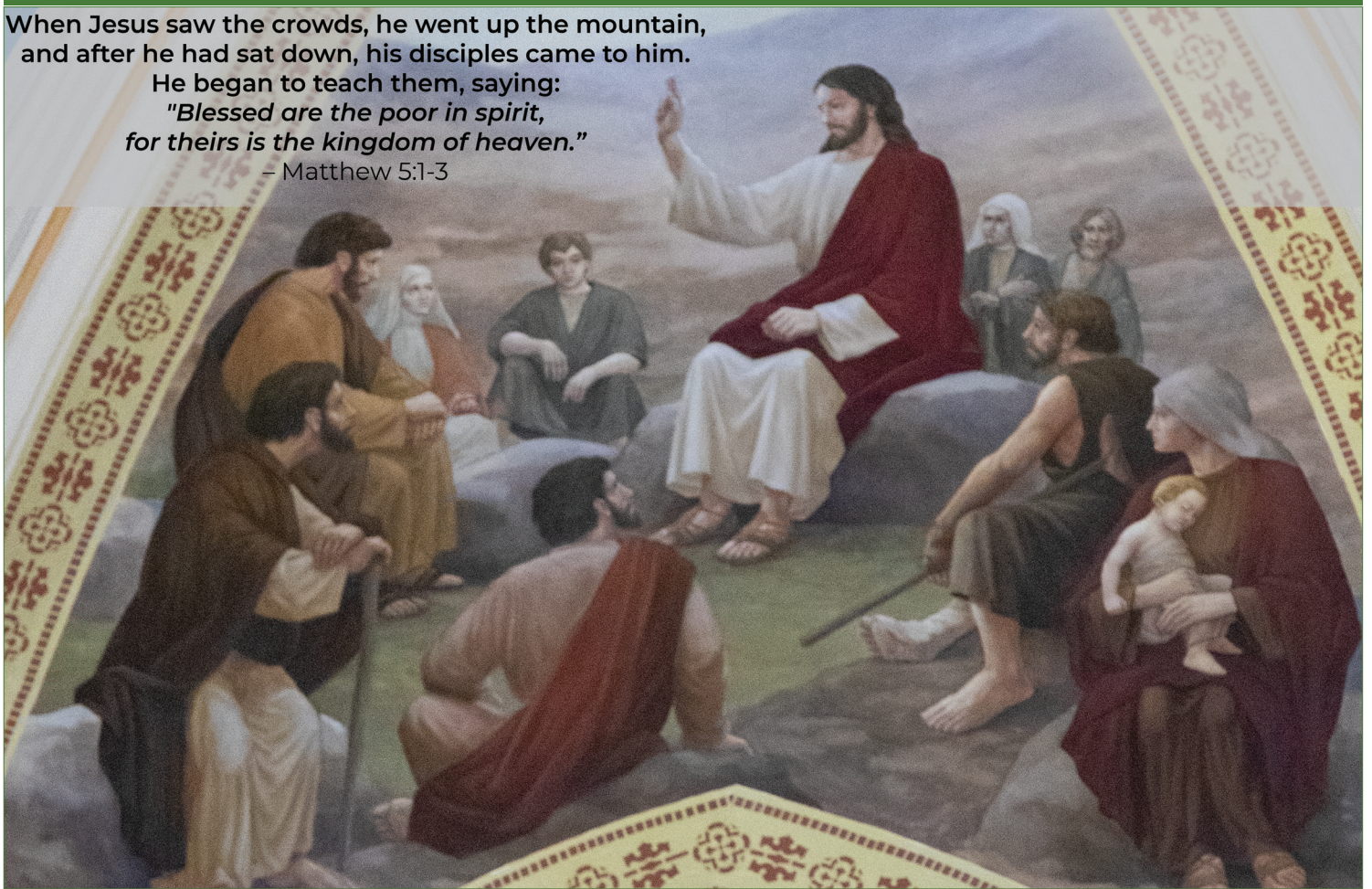

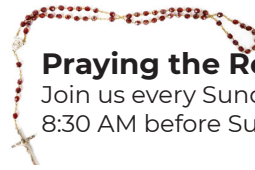
Traditional Blessing of the Throats
