CORPUS CHRISTI SETUP!

Reminder to all! Set up for our outdoor altars for the Corpus Christi procession is at 7:30 am on Sunday morning, June 11th. **One of the altars will be done by the Rosary Society at Sacred Heart which leaves 3 for St. Joseph Parish.**

Altar #1 will be on steps of the St. Vincent de Paul building closest to our church. Altar #2 will be on the front porch of St. Joseph rectory. Altar #3 will be on the front porch of our St. Joseph parish center. Altar #4 will be in the front main entrance doors of our St. Joseph church.

At least two vases of flowers are needed for each outdoor altar. We will provide the candles for each altar. Nice area rugs are needed for each outdoor altar and a kneeler placed at each outdoor altar. Many hands are needed to help set up and take down. Please offer your help with either set up or take down.
