ļ Feast of the Presentation of the Lord...

The Feast of the Presentation of Lord is celebrated 40 days after Christmas on February 2nd every year. In ways, this Feast celebrates the meeting between the Jewish Covenant and the New Covenant. Joseph and Mary fulfill the tradition of the Jewish Covenant by presenting their first born son with a sacrifice of two turtle doves. The New Covenant is realized as Jesus, the new temple of God enters the ancient temple and

is recognized by Simeon and Anna, Luke 2:22-40. Because Jesus is the "light of the world," this feast is also known as Candlemas and traditionally includes of the blessing of candles as well as a candlelight procession.
