

July Devotions Honoring Saint Anne

SAINT ANNE is the grandmother of our Lord Jesus, mother of the Blessed Virgin Mary, wife of Saint Joachim, father of the Blessed Virgin Mary and secondary patroness of the Diocese of Norwich. Devotions to Saint Anne will be on Mondays of July immediately following the 8 am Mass. Many turn in prayer to Saint Anne with all their needs and intentions. Here at St. Joseph Church the statue of SAINT ANNE is in our Shrine Room. The statue was a gift to our parish by Fr. Michael Gajewski (assistant pastor) and his Mom Mary Gaiewski in 1962. You may visit the statue of SAINT ANNE and light a votive candle either before or after Mass especially this month of July!

Saint Mary Magdalene...

Mary of Magdala, healed by the Lord Jesus, followed him and ministered to him with great love (cf. Lk 8:3). At the end, when all the disciples had fled, Mary Magdalene stood at the foot of the cross with Mary. John, and the other women (cf. Jn 19:25). Early Easter Morning, Jesus appeared to her and sent her to announce his resurrection to the disciples (cf. Mk 16:9, Jn 20:11-18)

Her cult spread throughout the Western Church, particularly in the eleventh century, and grew strong in the Order of Friars Preachers, according to the testimony of Humbert of Romans: "After [Mary Magdalene] was converted to penance, she received such grace from the Lord, as can be found in no other women in the world, except the blessed Virgin, to whom greater reverence is paid and is believed to have greater glory in heaven." (ed J. Catalani, Rome 1739, p210)

The Order of Preachers counts her among its protectors. The brethren and sisters venerate her as the "Apostle to the apostles" — a she is celebrated in the Byzantine Liturgy — and compare the role of the Magdalene to announce the resurrection with their own office.
