Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Over a week ago, we were amazed to watch the thousands of people walking the streets of Indianapolis for the Eucharistic procession, taking the National Eucharistic Revival to the streets in the most public display of our loving devotion to the Eucharistic. There were many bishops, priests, deacons, religious and lay people, including children who recently made their first Holy Communion, professing their faith in Jesus Christ, the Great High Priest and sharing in the breaking of the Eucharistic bread.

However, last Friday, we watched what seemed to be the opposite. A mockery of our loving devotion displayed at the Olympics in Paris. The drag queen-led parody of the Last Supper, portraying the apostles and a female DJ as Jesus, mocking Leonardo da Vinci's famous the Last Supper. It was showing the Last Supper as a display and public mockery of the Holy Eucharist. In showing it in this way, people can put Jesus away from their life, abandon His Church, live without God, and do what they want.

Of course, as the followers of Christ, we cannot return evil for evil in condemnation of this insult. We are not to burn the buildings, shops, apartments and cars on the streets like we have witnessed other groups protesting recently. But also, we cannot stand aside, hide our Faith under the bushel basket, remain silent, and quietly abide as the world mocks our most precious gift from the Lord Jesus.

In these challenging times of professing our Faith, we are called to intensify our commitment to Jesus Christ by committing ourselves to much greater and richer prayer and a more mature relationship with Jesus especially for the Bread of Life and fasting - not only from food but also trying to abstain from other things such as gossip, TV, social media and internet that take us away from a more sacramental life. May the Holy Spirit guide us in this spiritual endeavor.
