

Special Rosary Intention to St Monica

St. Joseph Rosary Society will be holding a special rosary intention Sunday, August 25, to St. Monica whose feast day is August 27th. She has become

One son fell away from the faith and was living a life under egregious sin, even fathering a child out of wedlock. Praying tirelessly and not giving up, finally, he came back to the Church. His name, St. Augustine! He became a bishop, a renowned theologian and prolific writer and Doctor of the Church! Through the intercession of Sts. Monica and Augustine, may our prayers be answered.
