

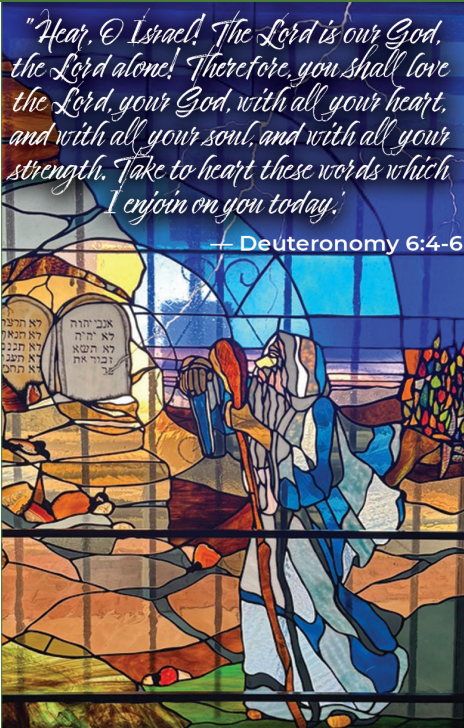

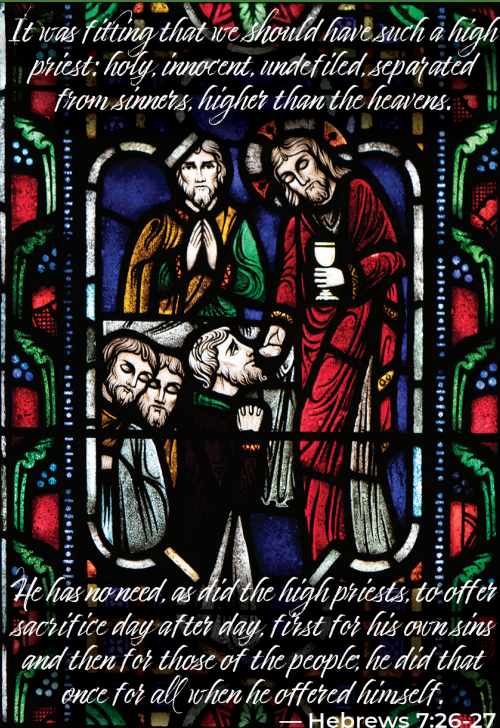

Many cultures throughout the world observe the celebration in memory of those who have died. Throughout the month of November, we remember in a special way our loved ones in our prayers.
