CHRISTMAS LETTER 2024

"Anioł Pasterzom Mówią: "Chrystus się wam narodził, W Betlejem, nie bardziej pod tym mieście, Narodził się w ubóstwie. Pan waszego stworzenia!"

"Pasterze słyszeli, jak aniołowie mówili: « Chrystus Pan dziś się narodził. Betlejem, niezbyt nisko w ten poranek, tam tak pokorne się On się narodził. Wielki Pan ziemi i nieba".

Drodzy Parafianie i Przyjaciele naszych Parafii, W Świętym Okresie Adwentu modliliśmy się, aby każdy z was znalazł okazję do refleksji nad własną wiarą i relacją z Panem Jezusem Chrystusem i Jego Kościółem. Czegokolwiek pragną nasze serca i dusze, czy zdajemy sobie z tego sprawę, czy nie, naszym ostatecznym pragnieniem jest sam Jezus Chrystus; z tego powodu jesteśmy przepełnieni radością i pocieszeniem w tym okresie Bożego Narodzenia. Wiemy, że wszyscy, na co liczymy, spełniło się w Osobie Świętego Dzieciątka Jezus. Pośród wszystkich naszych obecnych zmian i trosk, Miłość Boga objawia się nam w cudownym Darze Jego Syna, Jezusa Chrystusa. Wraz z aniołami z Betlejem nasza wiara pobudza nas do śpiewania w Wigilię Bożego Narodzenia

Boże Narodzenie ma w ten sposób przyprowadzać do Kościoła osoby i rodziny, które z różnych powodów nie były na Mszy św. lub sakramentach od miesięcy lub lat. Cóż za wspaniałą i pełną łaski okazja, aby odłożyć na bok dawne różnice i stare nawyki i rozpoczęć na nowo modlitewną relację z Panem Jezusem i Jego Kościółem. W Roku Świętego Jubileuszu, który rozpoczyna się w Wigilię Bożego Narodzenia 2024 r., kierujemy do was wszystkich otwarte i pełne wdzięczności serce gościnności! Obyśmy razem wzrastali w siłę i łasce, aby wspólnie poznawać i świętować Bożą obecność w naszym życiu i Jego panowanie nad wszystkimi rzeczami tego świata.
