

## **DIOCESE NEWS**



### Chrism Mass at the Cathedral

As announced last week, all our parishioners are invited to the consecration of the Chrism and the blessing of the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of the

Catechumens at the Chrism Mass on Wednesday, April 16, at 10:30 am. The Mass will be celebrated at the Cathedral of Saint Patrick in Norwich. Archbishop Christopher J. Coyne, Apostolic Administrator, will celebrate this liturgy. All are invited.

The **Sacred Chrism**, oil mixed with sweet perfume, symbolizes the presence of the Holy Spirit. It will be used in the parishes of the Diocese of Norwich in the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. It is also used at the Ordination of Bishops and Priests and at the Dedication of a Church and altar.

The **Oil of the Sick** is used to anoint those who are suffering from illness so that they may receive strength and healing, both physical and spiritual.

The catechumens will be anointed with the **Oil of Catechumens** in preparation for their Baptism at the Easter Vigil.

The Chrism Mass is a celebration of the entire local Church, and the subsequent use of the oils in the various parishes is a sign of unity among God's people.
