

## The Octave of the Assumption of Mary

The Octave of the Assumption of Mary is the eight-day celebration beginning on the Solemnity of the Assumption (August 15) and culminating on the Feast of the Queenship of Mary.

While the Assumption of Mary was not formally defined until 1950 by Pope Pius XII, the belief that Mary was Assumed body and soul instead of undergoing bodily corruption was commonly held by the early Church. This octave culminating in the Feast of the Coronation of Mary was added in 847 by Pope Leo IV however it was not uniformly celebrated in all dioceses. On the Feast of the Coronation of Mary, we remember that the Blessed Virgin Mary reigns in heaven together with her Son. She reigns not because she is in any way equal to God but because she is the mother of Christ the King. Her privileges come from her "fiat" during the Annunciation in which she willingly agreed to become the Mother of God and make our redemption possible. "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word."

Born in 332, St. Monica was married to a pagan husband and had 3 children. One son fell away from the faith and was living a life under egregious sin, even fathering a child out of wedlock. Praying tirelessly and not giving up, finally, he came back to the Church. His name, St. Augustine! He became a bishop; a renowned theologian and prolific writer; and a Doctor of the Church!

Through the intercession of Sts. Monica and Augustine, may our prayers be answered.

There will be 2 boxes (1 in the front vestibule and 1 in the side door entrance) where you can place the first name or initial (respect of privacy) of your loved ones. The boxes will then be placed by the Blessed Mother on this special Sunday rosary. Please join the Sunday group to pray the rosary before Mass for your loves ones!
