The "Black Madonna of Czestochowa," also known as **OUR LADY OF CZESTOCHOWA**, is a revered icon enthroned at the Jasna Gora Monastery on a hill in the City of Czestochowa, Poland, with a rich story rooted in history and tradition. According to Polish history, the icon was painted by Saint Luke on the tabletop built by Saint Joseph used by the Holy Family in Nazareth, and later rediscovered by Saint Helena, the mother



of the Roman Emperor Constantine, reportedly found in Jerusalem, who brought it to Constantinople where it was first venerated.
