Our Lady of Sorrows

Devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows flourished in the Middle Ages. It is traditionally celebrated September 15th, following the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (September 14th) however, popular devotion in many parts of the Mediterranean celebrate it with procession on the Friday before Holy Week.

Reflect on The Seven Sorrows

1: The Prophecy of Simeon Luke 2:34-35 Simeon tells Marv that Jesus is the Messiah! But, He will be rejected and her own soul will be pierced with a sword. Joy and Sorrow. How do I relate to Joy and Sorrow? How might I reject blessings God offers because they come with suffering and my own cross? 2: The Flight into Egypt Matthew 2:13-14 Joseph and Mary much leave everything they know behind and journey through the desert to protect their family and Jesus. I am willing to give up everything to allow God to lead me into the unknown? 3: The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple Luke 2:43-45 We celebrate with Jesus in Church then go off into our daily lives... Do I notice when He is missing in my life? Do I seek Him? 4: Meeting Jesus on the Way of the Cross Luke 23:26-28

Despite Simeon's prophesy, Mary goes to Jerusalem and allows her heart to be pierced by Jesus' rejection and crucifixion. Like Mary, do I accept the suffering of my own cross?

5: The Crucifixion of Jesus John 19:17-18, 26-30 All of Jesus' sufferings were Mary's sufferings as she watches her son's crucifixion. Like Mary, do I trust Jesus and not harden my heart against those who caused the suffering?

6: The Decent from the Cross John 19:38 Jesus' body is taken down from the cross and placed in Mary's arms. Mary accepts 'Thy Will be done' in this moment... Do I in suffering? 7: The Burial of Jesus John 19:39-42 Mary helps with the washing, anointing, and warping of Jesus' body in linen. It is always difficult to see death and life together, but Mary continued to believe, hope, and love. Do I when all seems lost?
