DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

Today marks the anniversary of the dedication of the Basilica of Saint John Lateran, the cathedral church of Rome. Erected by the Emperor Constantine, who converted a portion of the Laterani family palace into a church, the Lateran Basilica was dedicated by Pope St Sylvester on 9 November 324 as the papal church and residence. This feast was first observed only in Rome. Later, the feast was extended to the entire Latin Church, as the basilica is regarded as the mother church of Christendom. It also signifies devotion to and unity with the Chair of Peter. In honor of this, Pope Clement XII (1730-1740) placed an inscription wrapped around the facade which translates as: "Mother and head of all the churches of Rome and the world."

The basilica was the residence of the popes from the 4th century until their moving to Avignon, France, in 1309. Five ecumenical councils have taken place within her walls. The present structure was commissioned in 1646 by Pope Innocent X. Beneath the high altar lies the remains of the small wooden table on which, according to tradition, Saint Peter is said to have celebrated Mass.
