

Epiphany Tradition Of Chalking The Doors

"From the EAST THE MAGI came to Bethlehem to adore the LORD JESUS; and opening their treasures, they offered costly gifts: GOLD the THE GREAT KING, INCENSE to THE TRUE GOD, and MYRRH in SYMBOL OF HIS BURIAL. ALLELUIA!"

Then using the blessed chalk by a priest on the FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY, mark the lintel above the MAIN DOOR OF

THE HOUSE or THE TOP OF THE DOOR ITSELF AS FOLLOWS: $20 + (+ \mathcal{M} + \mathcal{B} + 25)$ and pray: "The THREE KINGS - CASPAR, MELCHIOR, BALTHASAR followed the STAR OF GOD'S SON WHO BECAME MAN TWO THOUSAND AND TWENTY-FIVE YEARS AGO. May CHRIST bless our home and remain with us throughout the NEW YEAR 2025 A.D. Concluding prayer: O LORD GOD, ALMIGHTY GOD, bless this house that it may become a shelter of health, charity, humility, goodness, mildness, self-conquest, chastity, obedience to the Commandments and Thanksgiving To GOD, FATHER, SON, and Holy SPIRIT. Upon this house, and those who dwell herein, may Thy blessing remain forever. Through Christ Our Lord. Amen.'
