

**ORDINARY TIME** began on Monday, January 13<sup>TH</sup>, 2025 and continues through Tuesday, March 4<sup>TH</sup>, 2025, the day before Ash Wednesday and the beginning of the LENTEN

WHAT IS ORDINARY TIME? "Besides the times of the year that have their own distinctive character, there remains in the Catholic Church's yearly liturgical cycle THIRTY-THREE WEEKS in which no particular aspect of the Mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the Mystery of Christ itself is honored in its fullness, especially on SUNDAYS. THIS PERIOD IS KNOWN AS "ORDINARY TIME" (Universal Norms, #43). The liturgical color is GREEN for the vestments of the Priest & Deacon. GREEN IS COLOR OF HOPE AND NEW LIFE!

The week of prayer for Christian unity is January 18th - January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025:. "Almighty and eternal God, you gather together the scattered sheep and watch over all those you have gathered. Look kindly on all

#### Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

In all Dioceses of the United Sates we observe every January 22<sup>nd</sup> - on the Supreme Court decision Roe vs Wade (1973), "A day of prayer and fasting for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person

committed through acts of abortion" (girm. #373). The mass "for giving thanks to god for the gift of human life (#48/la or b) from the masses and prayers for various needs and occasions may be celebrated by the priest with white vestments or the mass "for the preservation of peace and justice (#30) with violet vestments.
