

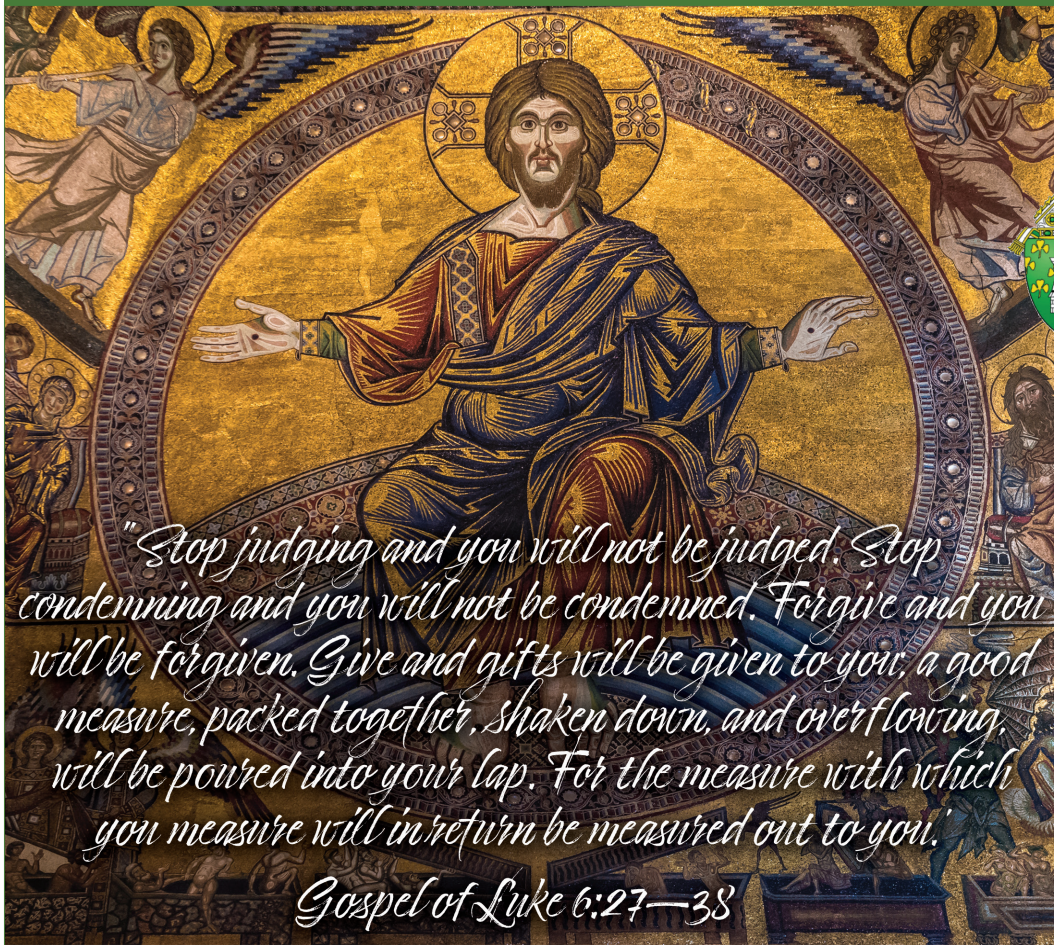

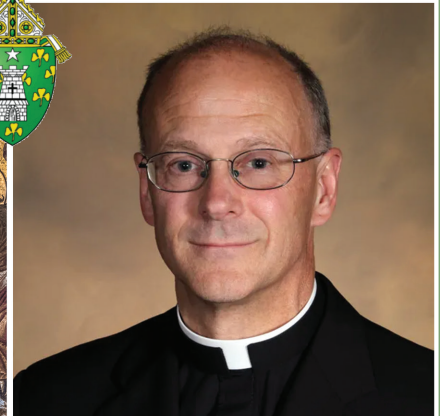

The Shroud of Turin: The Passion, Death, & Resurrection of Jesus Christ!

Sunday, March 9TH at 12 noon in the Sacred Heart Church Hall. Presented by Sean Fitzgerald, who has

a Master's Degree in Religious Studies and Theology from St. Joseph Seminary, Yonkers NY of the Archdiocese of New York. He also has a Post-Graduate Certification in Shroud Studies from the Pontifical Athenaeum Regina Apostolorum in Rome. This Lenten Presentation is like a RETREAT with emphasis on how the Shroud is a reflection of the Gospels. There is a slide presentation as well as discussion on tradition, history and science regarding the Shroud. The Shroud of Turin is believed to be the actual burial cloth of the body of Jesus when it was placed in the tomb.
