Divine Mercy Sunday 2025

JEZU, UFAM TOBIE! = JESUS, I TRUST IN YOU!

THE LORD JESUS expressed HIS WILL with regard to THIS SUNDAY'S EASTER FEAST in HIS very first revelation to Sister Saint Faustina Kowalska.

The most comprehensive revelation can be found in her *Diary: Divine Mercy In My Soul*, which reads in part:

I desire that the feast of mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners.

On that day the very depths of my tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon these souls who approach the fount of my mercy. The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine flood gates through which graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to me, even though its sins be as scarlet (Diary, 669).



In all, Saint Faustina Recorded 14 revelations from Jesus Christ concerning His desire for this feast! Make sure you don't miss these graces by celebrating the "25th Divine Mercy Sunday and the "25th Anniversary of the Canonization of Saint Faustina Kowalska by Pope Saint John Paul II in April 2000.
