

At a meeting of the bishops of the ecclesiastical Province of Hartford, of which the Diocese of Norwich is part, the Bishops decreed that fifteen dollars (\$15) is to be the amount for stipends for Masses, effective January 1, 2026. In the Diocese of Norwich, this will replace the current practice of a \$20 stipend for weekend Masses and a \$10 stipend for weekday Masses. Starting on December 17th, the church beings singing the "O" Antiphons in Evening Prayer drawing on the hope and promise of the Lord's "Coming."
