

#### **Epiphany & Closing of the Holy Year**

The Jubilee Year proclaimed by Pope Francis will end on Epiphany. Special graces, called Indulgences, are available to pilgrims at Saint

Patrick Cathedral. On Sunday, January 4, 2026, at 2:00 pm. we will have Adoration and pray the Liturgy of the Hours along with confessions so the faithful may have one last opportunity to participate in the Holy Year graces. Emmanuel - God is M

Today we hear God telling Ahaz, the King of Judah, to ask for a sign. "Ask for a sign from the LORD, your God; let it be deep as Sheol, or high as the sky!" Ahaz's response seems logical: "I will not ask! I will not tempt the LORD!" Syria and Ephram are threatening Judah. God sends the prophet Isaiah to assure Ahaz that God is with his people. When Ahaz fails to believe Isaiah, God Himself offers to give Ahaz a sign of God's support and presence. Ahaz's refusal represents a lack of Trust and Faith in God's Presence.

Mary's response is different. When told that she will embody the sign given to Ahaz, that she has been "set apart" to be the one through which God becomes human, her fiat places total and complete Trust and Faith in God. Even when she knows a pregnancy out of wedlock would mean exclusion from society and possibly being stoned to death for assumed adultery, she Trusts God will keep her safe. She is not tempted by pride to run off to tell the religious authorities what she has experienced. She holds her experience in the silence of her heart and hastens to assist Elizabeth, who is pregnant with John the Baptist. Mary Trusts God to overcome human challenges that seem insurmountable. She Trusts God to explain to Joseph that she has not been unfaithful to him. Instead, she has profound Faith in both God and Joseph, whom God has chosen as Jesus' foster-father. She deeply knows God is with her, Joseph, and all people!
